

Residents of West Vancouver will be pleased to have a co-operative auto network car at Hollyburn Plaza

West Vancouver, September 15, 2008 – Residents of West Vancouver will be pleased to have a Co-operative Auto Network car at Hollyburn Plaza in Ambleside. The car will provide residents of West Vancouver who don't need a car on a daily basis to forego ownership of their own vehicle while having the option to use a vehicle when they need it. There are hourly and per kilometer usage fees cover all the costs, including insurance, cleaning, vehicle maintenance, permit parking and gasoline.

Since October 1999, Hollyburn Properties Limited and Co-operative Auto Network have been working together and have placed seven vehicles in Hollyburn buildings with the recent placement of a new vehicle at The Skyline (1305 West 12th Avenue, Vancouver) in the South Granville neighbourhood. Hollyburn Properties Limited and Co-operative Auto Network are currently working at placing another vehicle at Hollyburn's North Vancouver property (Marlborough Tower) adjacent to the new North Vancouver City Library. Plans are underway to place vehicles at all Hollyburn buildings in Vancouver.

To date, Hollyburn Properties continues to be the only property management company working with Co-operative Auto Network and their sole reason for being involved has been for the benefit of their residents and the environment and not for development purposes.

The services of Co-operative Auto Network are offered to all Hollyburn residents. Events are hosted throughout the buildings to create awareness and to highlight the benefits of the program for individuals. There are already many Hollyburn residents that belong to the network.

Hollyburn Properties recognizes that corporate environmental responsibility is important to both its residents and the wider community. In 1992, Hollyburn Properties made a commitment to decrease energy consumption to minimize the environmental impact of its operation. A dedicated corporate energy management team was formed and under the guidance of this innovative team, Hollyburn Properties has achieved a reduction in energy consumption in all Hollyburn buildings.
